SCIENTIFIC PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Presenter (Author and Co-author) should be a registered delegate for the 1st ISOI PG Convention 2026.
- Paper can be submitted under either of the categories:
 1. Faculty/Practitioner
 2. PG student
- All the paper presentations should be categorized as: original research, case report & review.
- Abstract should not be exceeding 250 words, including the Title.
- The content for presentation should include: -
 - *For original research: Background, methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusion.
 - *Case reports: Background, Case report, Discussion and Conclusion.
 - *Review: Background, Discussion, Summary, and Conclusion.
- There can be a maximum of 2 authors (one presenting author and one co-author).
- The presentation should not have been submitted or presented at any other state, national or international scientific meeting.
- Names of guiding staff or HOD or college name should not be mentioned in the presentation.
- The presentation should be made compatible with Windows 10 and above and Microsoft version 11/12/13 to avoid last minute hassle.
- The presentation has to be submitted in a pendrive, one session prior to the allocated time slot.
- All presenters are requested to report well on time and be present 15 minutes before the start of their respective sessions.
- A total of 8 minutes will be provided for presentation followed by 2 minutes of Q&A
- Last date for abstract submission is **15th June 2026.**

SCIENTIFIC E- POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Presenter (Author and Co-author) should be a registered delegate for the 1st ISOI PG Convention 2026.
- E-poster can be submitted under either of the categories:
 1. Faculty/Practitioner
 2. PG student
- All the poster presentations should be categorized as: original research, case report & review.
- There can be a maximum of 2 authors (one presenting author and one co-author).
- The presentation should not have been submitted or presented at any other state, national or international scientific meeting.
- The E-poster should be prepared as a single PowerPoint slide in the 16:9 widescreen format.
- The presentation should be made compatible with Windows 10 and above and Microsoft version 11/12/13 to avoid last minute hassle.
- Poster should be understandable to the viewers, have a clear structure and layout with a minimum amount of text. It should be easily readable from a distance of 5 meters.
- Slide transition, animation files or sound links should not be used in the e-poster.
- Names of guiding staff or HOD or college name should not be mentioned in the e-poster.
- The E-poster has to be submitted in a pendrive, one session prior to the allocated time slot.
- All presenters are requested to report well on time and be present 15 minutes before the start of their respective sessions.
- A total of 3 minutes will be provided for presentation followed by 2 minutes of Q&A
- Last date for abstract submission is **15th June 2026**.
